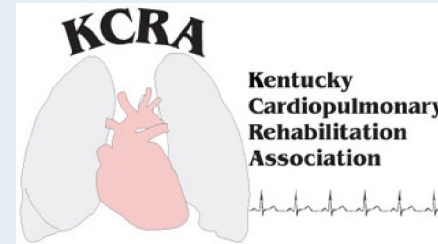

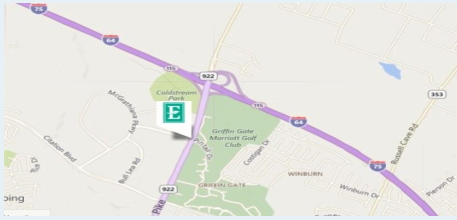

From Bluegrass Airport:

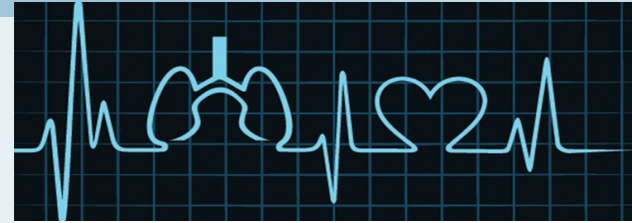
Turn left on Man-O-War Blvd from Airport.
